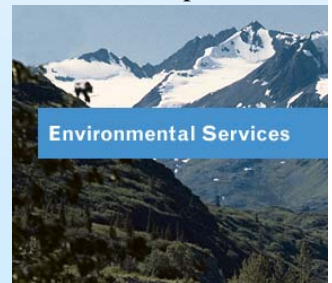
Access MSE through GSA Schedule 899

MSE can provide federal clients with total environmental solutions through GSA Environmental Services Schedule 899. MSE's Federal Supply Schedule can be viewed at <http://www.gsaelibrary.gsa.gov>. Type Millennium Science & Engineering in the search box and you will be directed to our schedule.

What is the Environmental Services Schedule 899?

Environmental Services, Schedule 899, is a Multiple Award Schedule that provides Federal Agencies a streamlined procurement process to acquire all of the services necessary to assist in complying with environmental initiatives and meeting goals through qualified contractors. MSE is authorized to perform the following Environmental Services:

- **Environmental Planning Services and Documentation** (899-1)
- **Environmental Compliance Services** (899-2)
- **Environmental Occupational Training Services** (899-3)
- **Waste Management Services** (899-4)
- **Geographic Information Services (GIS)** (899-7)
- **Remediation Services** (899-8)



ADVANTAGES OF GSA SCHEDULES

- GSA fixed labor rates have already been determined to be “fair and reasonable”.
- Easy access to commercially available services.
- Establish Blanket Purchase Agreements (BPAs) and negotiate even better pricing.
- All applicable laws and regulations have been complied with (including small business set-aside determination).
- Schedule orders count toward agency's socioeconomic goals.
- FedBizOpps (FBO) synopsis is not required.
- For DoD Agencies, using the GSA e-buy (electronic Request for Quote) meets the DoD Section 803 competition requirement.
- For non-DoD Agencies, competition requirements are met when at least three schedule contractors have been sent a Request for Quote.
- Maximum order limitations have been removed – Replaced by large order price reduction.

Authorized Users:

- All federal agencies and activities in the Executive, Legislative and Judicial branches
- Government Contractors authorized in writing by a Federal Agency pursuant to 41 CFR 101-26
- Mixed Ownership government corporations
- The government of the District of Columbia
- Other activities and organizations authorized by statute or regulation to use GSA as a source of supply
